- Value collaboration with teachers and school leadership.
- Have experience and investment in project-based learning as a philosophy for teaching.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Work within MBCI's Student Support Team responsible for the wholistic support of all students in the school in areas of personal, spiritual, academic, behavioral and interpersonal development.
- Coordinate necessary clinical services with external service providers.
- Provide support and leadership to Education Assistants, and peer tutor program.
- Work alongside teachers to prepare, implement and evaluate IEPs and Student Support Plans and provide and facilitate PD opportunities for staff.
- Collaborate with school leadership, teachers, parents, and other school staff to identify and address student needs and concerns.
- Provide ongoing learning support for International Students.

- Training and/or experience as a Resource Teacher and in supporting EAL students, or willingness to continue certifications.
